



## Covid-19 Information

As part of Andy's Hub commitment to provide safe in-home services, we want our partners and families to feel safe and comfortable as we continue our in-home placements. It is strongly suggested that Client and Service Partner take part in a **pre-screening phone call** prior to the first session to discuss Covid-19 and the risk factors/prevention methods. Andy's Hub requires all service partners and participants to sign Covid-19 waivers prior to starting services.

Client/Service Partner may wish to use the questions below as part of a pre-screening phone call.

### Pre-screening phone calls - Suggested screening questions:

- Have you, or anyone you have been in contact with tested positive for Covid-19?
- Have you, or anyone you have been in contact with experienced any Covid-19 symptoms, but not been tested? (*Symptoms may include: Cough/ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing/Fever/ Chills/Repeated shaking with chills/Muscle pain/ Headache/Sore throat/New loss of taste or smell*)
- If you answered yes to either of the above, did either of these exposures occur less than 14 days ago?
- Have you or anyone in your household used public transportation less than 14 days ago?
- Should we exchange temperature checks for everyone present at the start of the session?
- Would you like me/us to wear a mask while we are together?
- How should we communicate about this going forward?
- Are there any other preventative measures you have been using, that you would like to use during this placement?
- Are there any questions that should be passed onto the Andy's Hub administration team?

### Symptoms:

While Clients and Service Partners should look to organizations such as the CDC and local health departments, at the time this document was published, a person infected by Covid-19 may exhibit at least one of the following symptoms.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

### Emergency warning signs:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- New confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face
